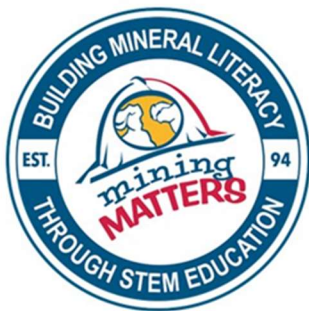


# Building Mineral Literacy with STEM: Teacher Training Project
