

Supporting Mining Education

Mining Engineering Options

During the development of the IMII, one of the first initiatives was to support the 2011/2012 course expenses for two *option* programs at the University of Saskatchewan:

- Introductory Course (GEOE 377.03)
- Ventilation Course (GEOE 498)

As of September 5, 2013, the two mining engineering courses, **Mine Ventilation** and **Introduction to Mining and Mineral Processing**, continue to be offered in the College of Engineering.

Mine Ventilation

This class has been offered twice as a special topics class, GEOE 498. First in 2011-12, with 26 students enrolled, and then in 2012-13 with 24 students enrolled.

The class is now permanent and has been numbered GEOE 380 – Mine Ventilation due to the additional resources provided by IMII.

Introduction to Mining and Mineral Processing

This course was introduced in 2009-10 as a special topics class, GEOE 498; with enrolment of 34 students in 2009-10 and 33 students in 2010-11. The course was given a permanent number of GEOE 377 in 2011-12.

Enrolment has remained at capacity with 31 students in 2011-12 and 42 students in 2012-13.
